Thank you for subscribing to the FEDRO vehicle data newsletter. Below you will find important information on the subject of vehicle data from the Federal Roads Office FEDRO.

1. Migration of freely available FEDRO vehicle data (www.ivz-opendata.ch)

The data repository of open FEDRO vehicle data available at www.ivz-opendata.ch and https://ivz-opendata.ch/opendata/ will soon be replaced by a new FEDRO data platform. You can now find our open data under the following path in the 'ivzod' directory (Informationssystem Verkehrszulassung Open Data):

The existing folder structure remains unaltered. The new FEDRO data platform is already in operation and is being run parallel to WebDAV. Please switch to the new path as soon as possible, as parallel operation will soon be discontinued. The old paths will not be redirected to the new path.

Parallel operation:

The new web server is now in operation. The old web server www.ivz-opendata.ch will continue to operate for another two months and will then be taken off the net. There will be no redirection.

We recommend that you use the new web server with immediate effect and update all links.

Reason for the changeover:

With the introduction of the new data platform, several solutions in use are being replaced or merged and harmonised. The new solution enables us to offer a high-performance storage system for the freely available FEDRO vehicle data.

2. Changes to NEUZU_IMPORTKANAL data set

In the new standardised authorisation procedure via eCOC (type approval = IVI), the import channel is no longer visible. There is therefore now a separate NEUZU_IM-PORTKANAL data record for the import channels each quarter. From 16 January, the data record will include the fuel code and the first three digits of the chassis number

(global manufacturer code). This enables more precise analysis of the market situation: Dataset NEUZU IMPORTKANAL

4. Seven-digit licence plates

Cantonal road traffic offices will in future be able to issue licence plates with a sevendigit number sequence. Please ensure that your applications and information systems are ready for the input or display of seven-digit licence plates.
